

# Pool Schedule 2023 – Sawmill Village I Pool

- Pool season starts on Saturday, May 27<sup>th</sup>. (Memorial Day Weekend)
- Pool will be open seven days a week from 11:00 A.M. until 7:00 P.M.
- Last day of pool is on Labor Day. (Monday, September 4<sup>th</sup>.)

## POOL RULES AND GUIDELINES

### WARNING: NO LIFEGUARD ON DUTY – SWIM AT YOUR OWN RISK

- You must use your fob to enter the pool.
  - Keep gate closed at all times.
  - Do not open the gate for anyone outside your group.
  - Anyone you let into the pool area will become your responsibility.
  - Anyone under 18 must be accompanied and supervised by an adult.
  - Each unit can have up to 6 people and members are responsible for their guests at all times.
  - In case of thunder, exit the pool immediately.
  - In order to go in the water, proper pool attire is required at all times.
  - Please, use a towel before sitting on lounges and chairs as per manufacture's advice.
  - Smoking and drinking alcoholic beverages are NOT permitted in the pool area.
  - Glass containers are not permitted in the pool area.
  - No grilling or any electrical cooking devises are allowed in the pool area.
  - Keep any food away from water. NO EATING OR DRINKING on edge of the pool.
  - No chewing gum in the pool area.
  - Please, keep all areas clean.
  - Be mindful and respectful toward others, especially when playing games in the pool.
  - Loud and unruly behavior will not be tolerated.
  - For safety reasons: NO RUNNING, NO DIVING, NO FLIPPING, NO CLIMBING.
  - Oversized floats are not allowed.
  - Keep bathroom doors closed at all times.
  - Children in diapers or not fully trained must use the proper SWIM DIAPER.
  - Please, use the outside trash can to dispose dirty diapers.
  - No pets are allowed in the pool area.
  - Everyone must be out of the pool by 7:00 PM.
  - Pool hours must be observed. No trespassing before or after hours.

- ✓ Residents/Members (and/or their guests) could be subject to fines (minimum of \$50) and could also lose the pool privileges by violating the pool rules.
  - ✓ Residents/Members (and/or their guests) that cause any damage to pool property will have to cover all costs of fixing the damage and could lose pool privileges.
